How to Start a House Church!

Congratulations! You're on your way to starting a House Church! Here's a simple guide that details everything you need to know about starting your own House Church.

House Church Roles:

A House Church Leader has:

- 1. A <u>room</u> or <u>space</u> that can accommodate the number of people anticipated.
- 2. The willingness to host a weekly gathering.
- 3. A dedication to <u>contact/follow up</u> with people who miss service or have needs.
- 4. A <u>commitment</u> to play the role of a steward of God's church, and not an owner.
- 5. A commitment to hold <u>Scripture as the ultimate authority</u>, pointing people back to the Word of God and the Holy Spirit and not to opinion or theory.
- 6. A commitment to <u>continually grow</u> in your own spiritual walk.
- 7. A desire to be fruitful and a commitment to multiply.

Ultimately, you are a shepherd! Though there are administrative responsibilities, you are being entrusted by the Lord to help care for His sheep.

You will want to train up additional leaders – with the hope of eventually multiplying and sending out leaders to plant their own house churches!

A House Church Co-Leader: shares the responsibility of leading the church and is able to take on any pastoral and leadership responsibilities as needed. Many times, this role is fulfilled by a spouse.

Other roles you may want to recruit are:

- 1. Host(s)
- 2. Worship Leader(s)
- 3. Greeter(s)
- 4. Administrator(s)

House Church Service Outline + Explanation:

Times are suggested and vary.

- **1. Watch Network Video** This video is an apostolic greeting from your Network Leaders, that include announcements and an opportunity to give to your network through the Jesus Disciple web-app.
- **2. Loving Accountability (5 min.)** Questions can include "What did you hear from Jesus this week?" and "Did you share your story or the gospel this week?"
- **3. Worship and Communion (10 min.)** Leading your church to give thanks, individually or corporately, as well as lifting your voices in praise and worship. Plus, communion at least monthly.

- **4. Pray for One Another (5 min.)** Invite the church to share needs and pray for one another, allowing the Holy Spirit to minister through you.
- **5. Bible Study and Response Video (30 min.)** With both text and combination studies available, you can choose any study that best suits your House Church, or even engage in a Jesus Disciple Territory as a House Church. Of course, you may also teach live using any Jesus Disciple study content or teach straight from a Bible text.
- **6. Prayer for Evangelism and Multiplication (5 min.)** You are training your House Church members to pray, and are leading them to boldly pray for laborers, souls, and multiplication.

Prepare to Launch:

- 1. Prepare your Heart (PRAY!)
- 2. Prepare your Space (Arrange the space and consider all 5 senses)
- 3. Create both your profile and your House Church in Jesus Disciple web-app. (Click here to create a profile.)
- 4. Prepare the People (Invite and Remind)
 - If they decide to regularly attend your House Church, send them your church's "invite new members" link.
- 5. Prepare the Service (Worship, Communion, and Study)
